(a) to (c) The Government has issued draft notification G.S.R 658 (E) dated 04.07.2016 giving a period of thirty days to all the concerned stakeholders for their comments/suggestions. No comments were received within the stipulated time and the final notification was issued vide G.S.R 1034 (E) dated 02.11.2016 mandating all goods vehicles of Category N2 and of Category N3, either manufactured by a vehicle manufacturer or a body builder on drive away chassis vehicles, be fitted with an air conditioning system for the cabin with effect from the 1st April, 2017
